5.1. MOTTO OF THE TRUST:

Socio-economic development of people irrespective of caste, creed, gender, disability, color, ethnicity, religion or other characteristics by helping people realise their potential through knowledge empowerment and skill enhancement.

5.2. OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST:

The Objectives of the Trust are:-

- 1. To make people self-sufficient by providing livelihood training to economically weak people from rural and urban areas.
- 2. To create awareness among people about various government schemes and to help them take advantage of these facilities.
- To start programs on Human Rights.
- 4. To create environmental awareness among people and to start various initiatives for the same.
- 5. To train farmers and to work for the development of farmers by introducing old and new technologies appropriate for farming.

5.3. BENEFIT OF THE TRUST:

6. THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST

- (a) The said sum of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only) above referred to the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Trustees;
- (b) Properties movable or immovable, that may be acquired by the Trust either by purchase or otherwise;
 - (c) Additions and acceptations to the Trust fund;
- (d) Voluntary donations both towards corpus or otherwise gifts, legacies or grants in cash or in kind accepted by the trustees;
- (e) Grants and contributions made to the Trust by the Government, Government bodies, Trust or Institutions, Trade Union or Societies etc
 - (f) Sums and assets which by and means become the property of the Trust.

7. CESSATION OF TRUSTEESHIP:

A Trustee mentioned below shall cease to be the trustee of the Trust in case of :-

- 1. Death
- 2. Mental infirmity
- 3. Resignation
- 4. On being rendered incapable to perform the duties of a Trustee
- 5. On being convicted in a court of law of any offence involving moral turpitude
 - 6. On being adjudged insolvent

8. APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEES:

Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees shall be filled up by the remaining members of the Trust by selecting a suitable person. The Trust Board shall consists of a minimum of 3 (three) Trustees and maximum of 11 (Eleven) Trustees.

9. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TRUST;

The administration of the TRUST shall vest with the Board of Trustees, which consist of.-

Sujata Nayak Chair Person Madhusmita Nayak Secretary Madhusmita Jena Treasurer

10. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES;

The Board of Trustees shall have the control and management of the Trust and exercise the following powers:

- a) To determine from time to time to commence and to take up the object and purpose for which the funds of the trust shall be used and allot and allocate to each of the objects such portion of the funds as they deem fit;
- b) To purchase and acquire any immovable property of any kind for this object of the Trust or as a source of income for the Trust;
- c) To sell, mortgage, or dispose of any immovable property/properties belonging to the Trust;
- d) To incur all expenditure necessary as in their own opinion useful for carrying out the objects and administration of the trust;
- e) To sell, lease, mortgage or dispose of any property, immovable property/properties belonging to the Trust;
- f) To open one or more bank accounts of the trust with any bank or banks as the Trustees may deem fit and deposit money of the Trust in the Bank accounts.
- g) To borrow for and on behalf of the Trust with or without security from banks, governments, universities or any other government body/bodies both central and state;
- h) To employ staff of all kinds necessary and useful for carrying out the objects of the trust;
- To incur such other items of expenditure as is necessary and incidental for carrying out the objects of the Trust;
- j) To institute, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, refer to arbitration or to do such things as are incidental and necessary, concerning the affairs of the Trust and to sign and verify pleadings, affidavits and other powers;
- k) To delegate all or any of the powers vested in the Trustees to anybody to frame rules, bylaws and other codes for the conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its transactions and establishing any Committee;
- 1) To accept contributions in cash or in kind either by way of addition to the trust funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the Trust;
- m) To establish ad hoc committees for any purpose.

11. Meetings of the Trustees:

a) The President shall preside over all the meetings of the trustees and in his absence the Vice-President shall preside such meeting and in the absence

b) The meetings of the Trustees may be convened by the President or under

his direction by any other Trustees;

c) The quorum of the meeting of the Trustees shall be three personally

d) In the event of equality of votes, the person presiding such meeting shall exercise casting vote (additional vote);

e) The Trustees shall hold at least two (2) ordinary meetings in each year;

f) The President will give at least two weeks' notice in writing, specifying the date, place and time of the meeting.

12. RESOLUTIONS:

a) The Trustees may exercise all the powers vested in them in clause 10 by resolution passed at a simple majority of the trustees attended such meetings of the Board of Trustees.

b) Any resolution in writing signed by all Trustees holding office for the time

being shall be valid and binding.

13. SUITS:

The Managing Trustee(s) of the Trust is/are authorized to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.

14. Execution of Documents:

All deeds, documents etc. shall be executed by the President, Vice-President and Secretary jointly representing the Trust.

15. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

a) The Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of all Trust money and of all the income and investments and all the outgoing expenses.

b) The year of account shall be the financial year commencing from 1st APRIL

and ending 31st March.

c) The Trustees shall each year issue a report setting out the accounts showing the income and expenditure of the Trust for the preceding year not later than six months from the end of the preceding year of accounts.

d) The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant who may be appointed for the purpose by the board of Trustees and the audited statement of accounts together with Auditors' report shall be laid before the Board of Trustees for approval.

16. BANK ACCOUNT:

The President along with the Vice-President shall operate bank account(s) jointly.

17. POWER TO ALTER RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The Board of Trustees shall have full power and authority to make and alter rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust.

18. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND:

The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to invest the funds of the Trust in movable or immovable properties, in such manner as they deem fit for the purpose of the objects of the trust provided that such investments shall be in accordance with the provision of Section 13(I) read with Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as well as of any other law for the time being in force as are applicable to charitable trusts.

19. REMUNERTION TO THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees are entitled for remuneration as fixed by the Board of Trustees from time to time. They shall also be entitled to receive out of pocket expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the functions of the Trust. Further the income and funds of the Trust will be solely utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment of Trustees by way profits, interest and dividend or otherwise.

20. INDEMNITY:

Every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund in respect of any loss arising from or contingent upon any investment made out of the monies of the Trust unless such loss shall have been occasioned by own negligence and also every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the Trust against all proceedings, suits, claims, costs, damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the matters or affairs relating to the Trust created by these presents or in the exercise of powers or discretion vested in them by virtue of these presents.

21. IRREVOCABILITY:

The Trust is irrevocable.

22. ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST:

The activities of the Trust shall be only within India and its Union territories and shall not be extended anywhere outside India.

24. DISSOLUTION:

On dissolution of the Trust, the net assets of the Trust shall be transferred to an association of persons or trust or society having similar objects of this Trust.
